Health & Safety Policy

The health and safety of our campers is our primary focus. **Our 2020 summer camps are currently scheduled to proceed as planned**. Like you, we are continually monitoring COVID-19 developments. If it is determined that our camps should be canceled, we will issue campers a full refund within 48 hours of cancelation (minus Ryzer card processing/convenience fees).

As an added safeguard our event offers Allianz Registration Protection insurance. For an additional fee, this insurance refunds your full registration fee if camp is held but you cannot attend or must leave early due to a covered injury or illness which includes COVID-19. We plan to take the following precautions at our camps.

- 1. We will be asking for or verifying body temperature at check-in. If a camper is present with fever, she will be given a full refund and asked to go home, get well and rest.
- 2. We will have hand sanitizer available and time set apart for hand washing before and after each session.
- 3. An athletic trainer will be present and accessible, as always, to address any injury or health concerns.
